- Australian organisations with an ABN, or
- National Parks and Wildlife Services or other Government agencies working with state NPWS

2. You must be implementing bushfire restoration works in one of the Local Government Areas (LGA's) listed by State or Commonwealth Government.

- Friends of the Koala (East Lismore -NSW)

4. Applicants will need to supply the following information:

- a completed species list order form from their selected supplier nursery
- an ABN or a Statement of Supplier form (linked form is in this application)
- evidence of current insurance status - public liability and/or professional indemnity
- a copy of a risk assessment form which includes COVID-19 mitigation strategies
- dates of planting

Priority will be given to projects and organisations that undertake work in or around national parks or state managed conservation areas
