NSW Wildlife Friendly Vets - Small Asset Grant 2021

The key goal of the grant program is to enable veterinary organisations (clinics, mobile clinics and hospitals) that support wildlife rescue and rehabilitation to **acquire an incubator/humidicrib** to be used in the treatment of native animals.

The program aims to achieve the following outcomes:

- Increase the number of wildlife that can be successfully treated in veterinary organisations in NSW.
- Decrease the cost of providing wildlife care to the vet practice.

The total amount of funds available for allocation under this grant program is \$50,000. Funds for this round are intended to be spent during 2021/2022 financial year (to June 30 2022) and will be allocated according to demonstrated need.

There is a maximum limit of \$3,000 per application. Organisations can apply for the cost of one incubator only, up to the maximum amount.

Please note: If successful, payment will be made by FNPW after purchase is made and receipt is uploaded in your Milestone 2 obligation.

Funding is provided through the Wildlife Heroes project, supported by the New South Wales Government through its Environmental Trust.

Priority will be given to:

- Organisations that have not previously received funding from FNPW
- Organisations that treat a large volume of wildlife annually
- Organisations that are willing to participate in a future data collection trial for wildlife rescue through the Wildlife Heroes program.

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Applicants Eligibility:

Applicants will be eligible for funding if they are:

- A veterinary clinic, mobile clinic or hospital in NSW registered as a Wildlife Friendly Vet through the Wildlife Heroes project (see [here](#) to register)
- Have the endorsement of the organisation's owner, practice manager, senior staff member or equivalent.

Applicants will not be eligible for funding if they are:

- Not registered as a Wildlife Friendly Vet clinic through the Wildlife Heroes project
- Based outside of NSW
- The application is not endorsed by the organisation's owner, practice manager, senior staff member or equivalent.

All applicant groups must also meet the following grant criteria:

- Have a current ABN and associated bank account
- Have no outstanding grant reporting requirements with FNPW or NPWS, or money owing to either organisation.
- Have a valid quote for the wildlife incubator/humidicrib that they wish to purchase at the time of application
- Be able to obtain their chosen wildlife incubator and submit a final report by 30 June 2022. Extensions for acquittal will not be granted.

Applicants MUST be able to comply with the following Milestone dates:

- Milestone 1 - Contract signing: by **April 1st 2022**
- Milestone 2 - Purchase of incubator/humidicrib and upload of receipt and invoice: by **April 29th 2022**
- Milestone 3 - Final grant report including photos and a story about the asset: by **June 30th 2022**
